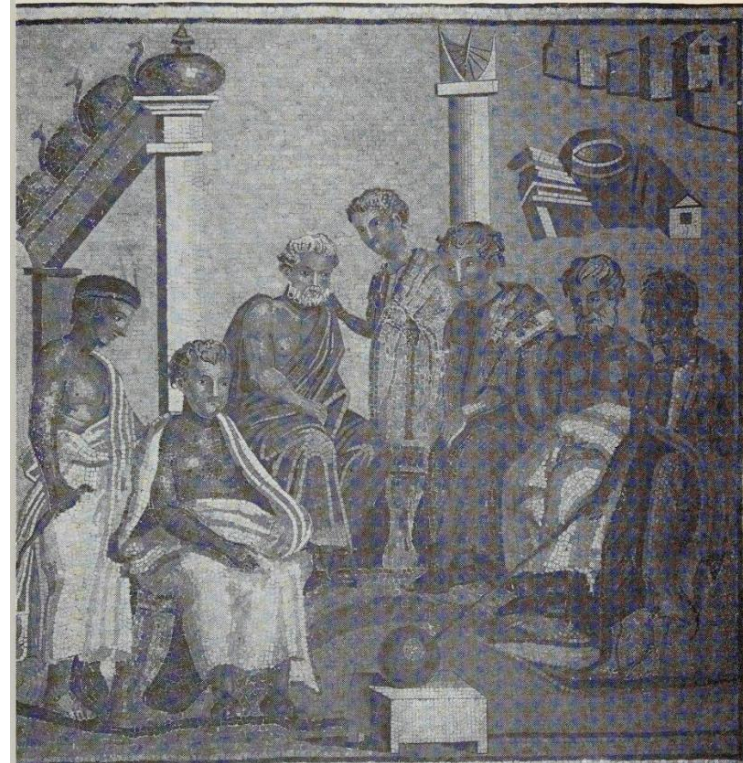

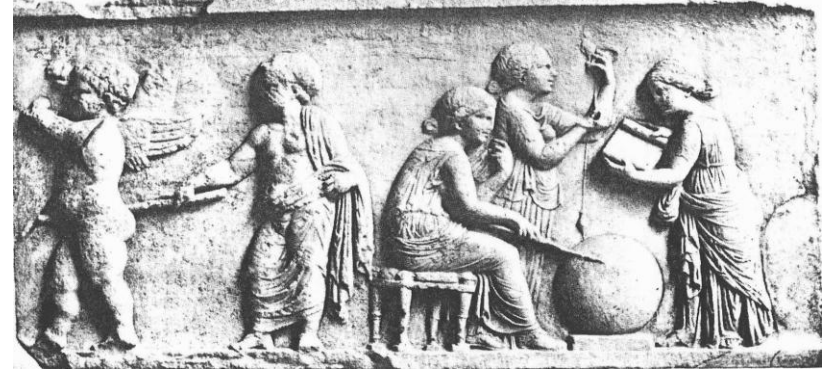

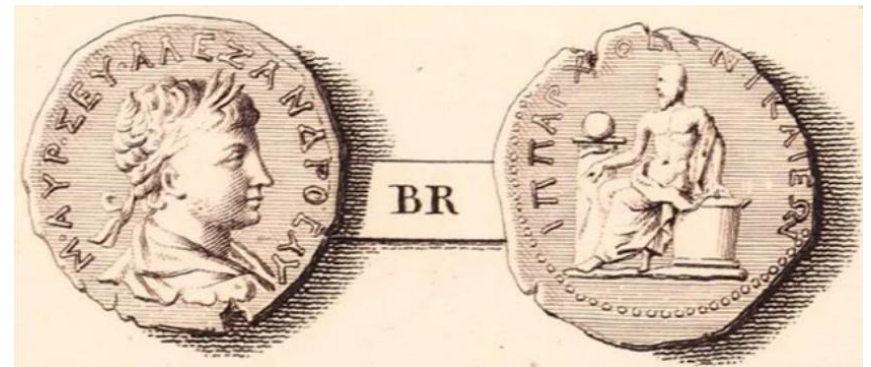


Hipparchus with globe (with NIK – A – IEΩN on rev.)

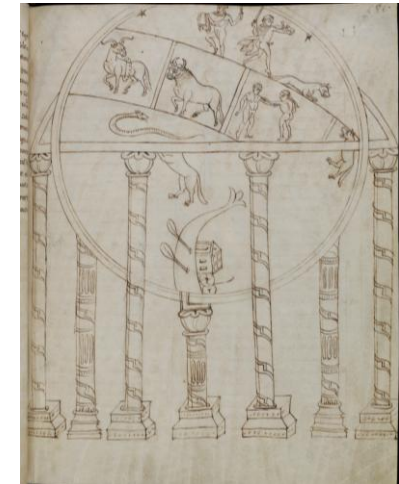

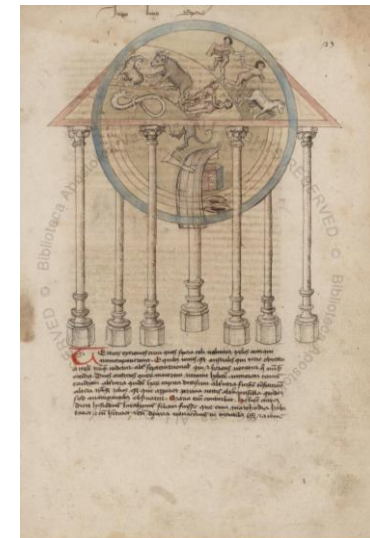

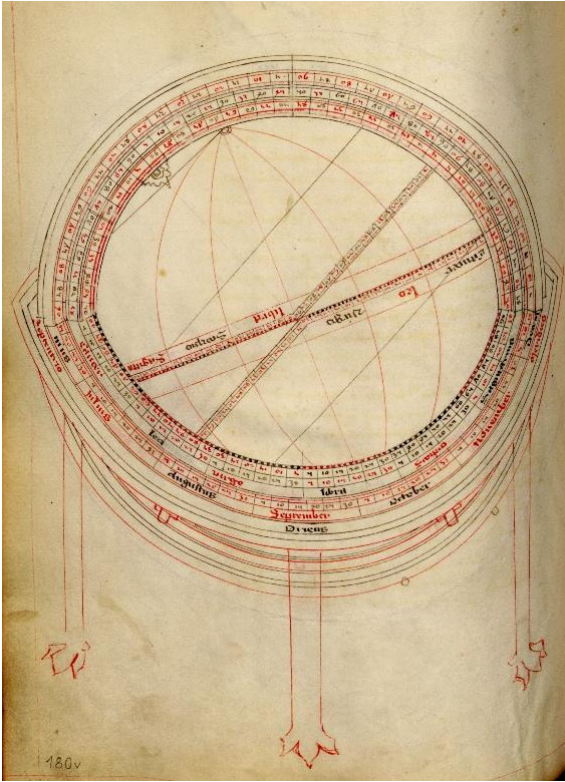
