

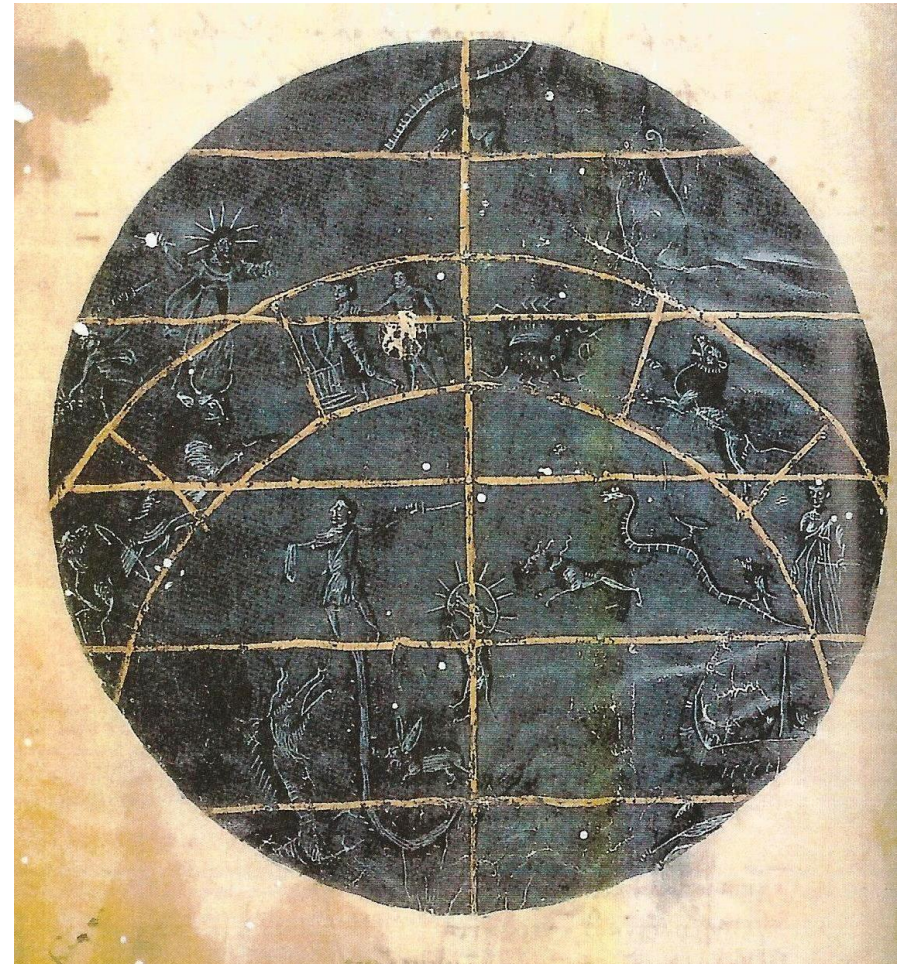
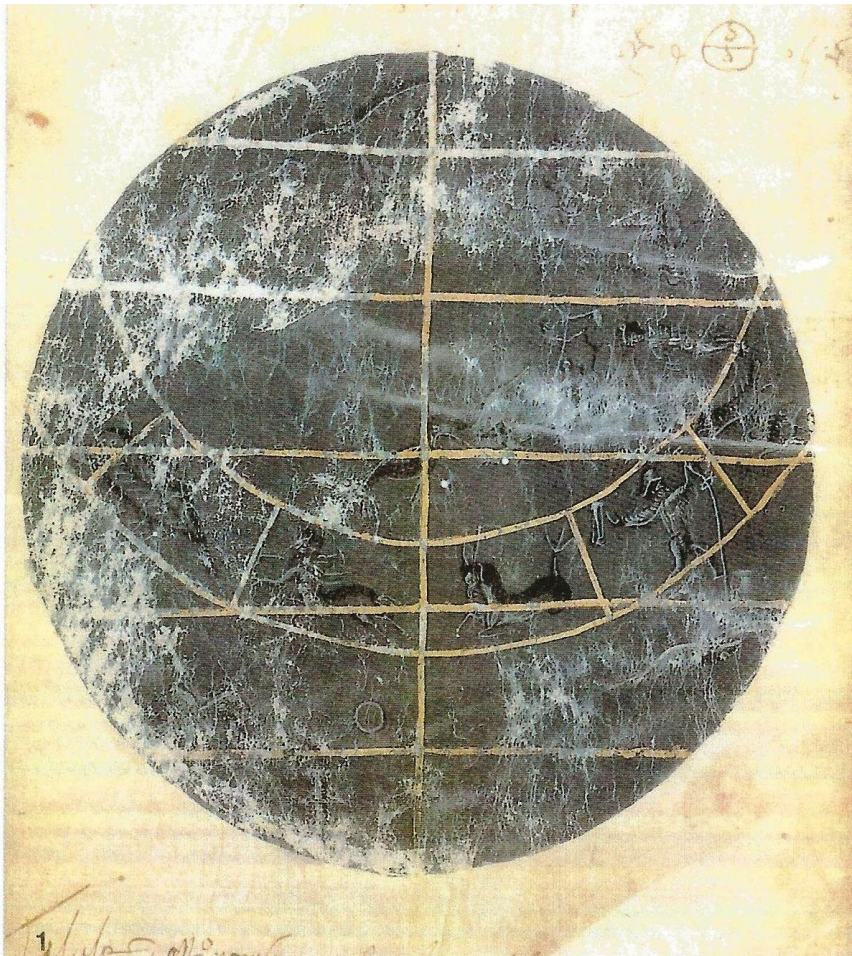

 bronze, 2nd C AD

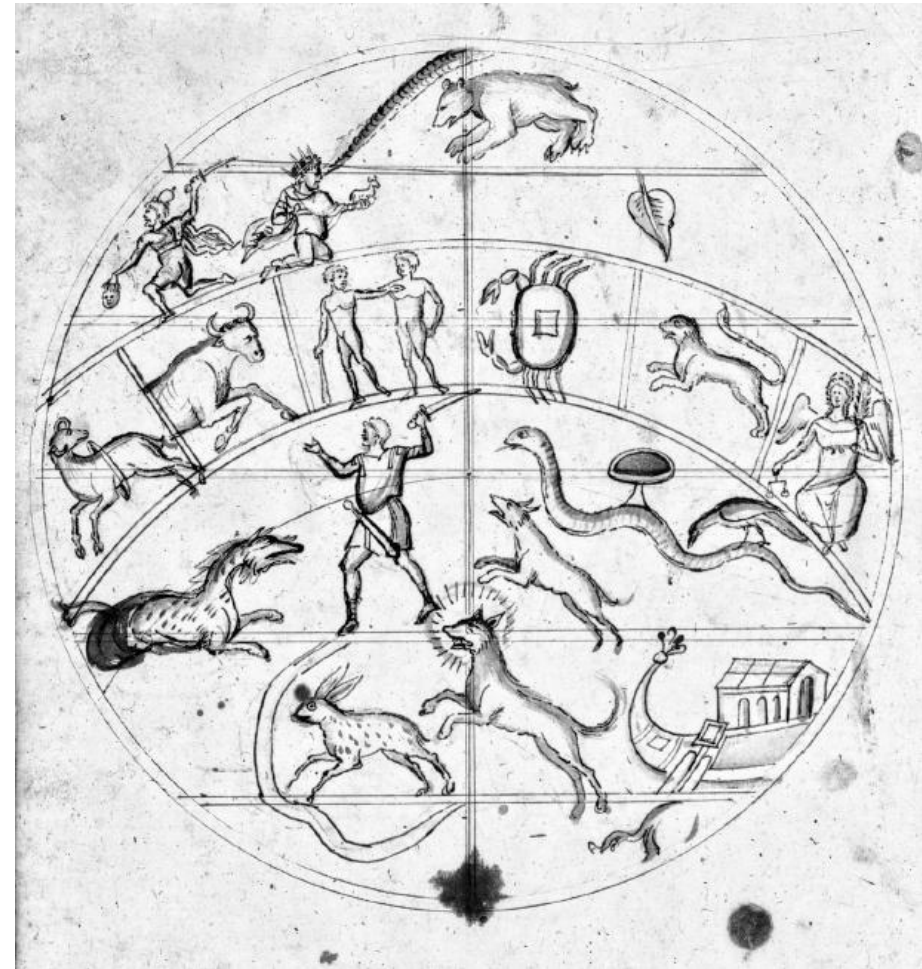
note – ecliptical; with Andromeda, Triangulus, Perseus, and Auriga, with Aries, Taurus and Gemini at the edges

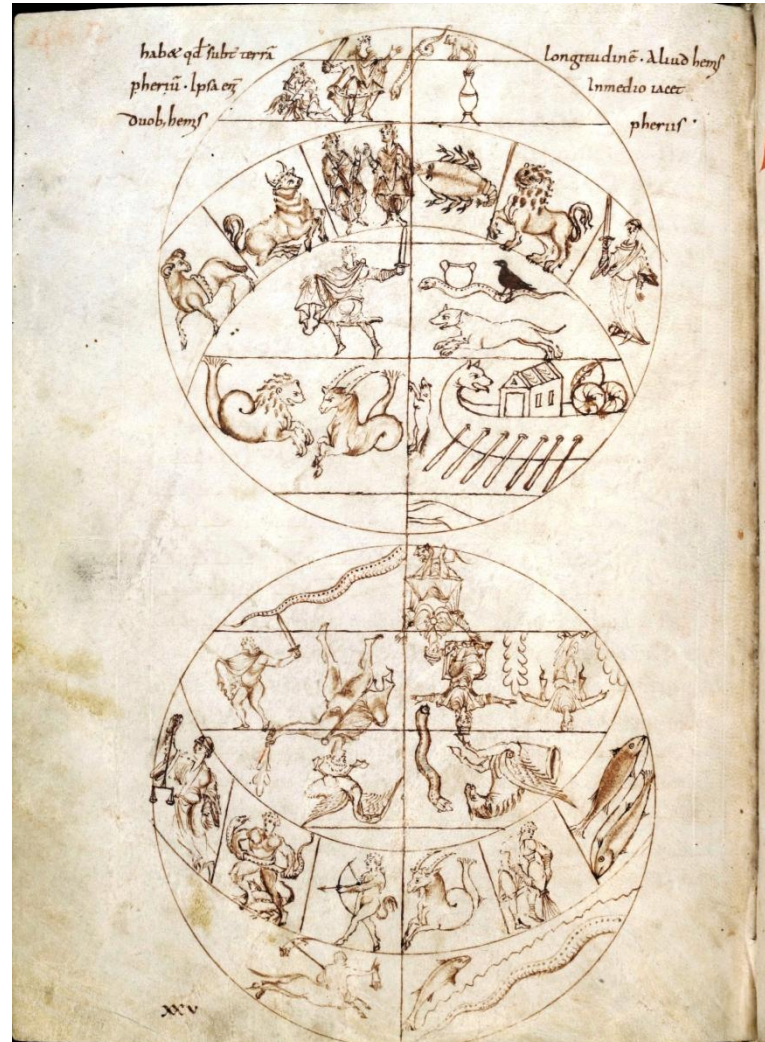

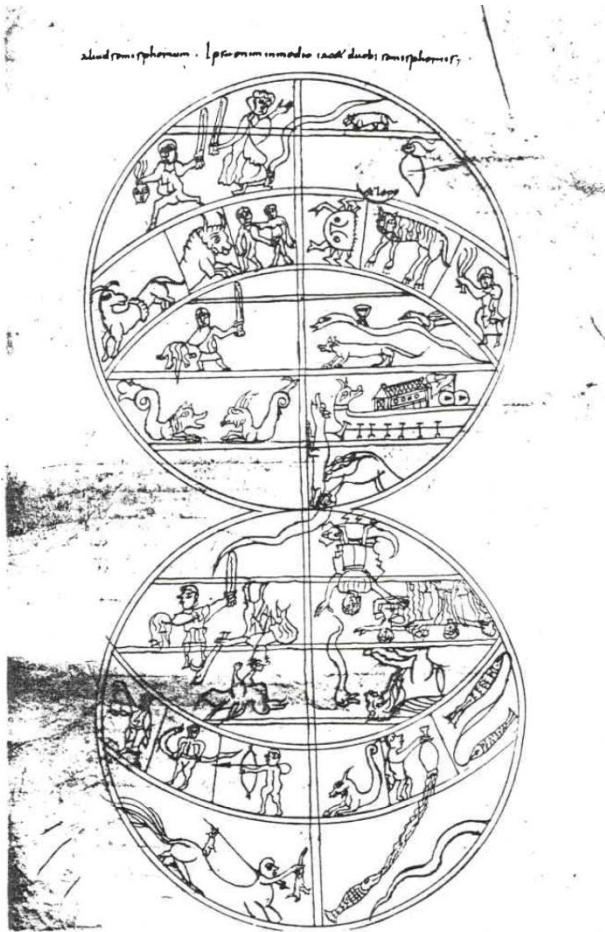

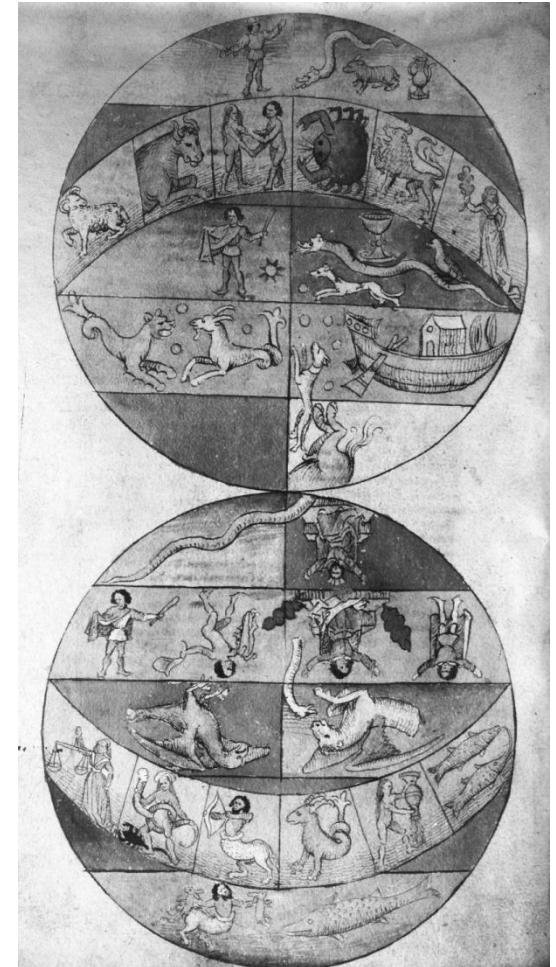

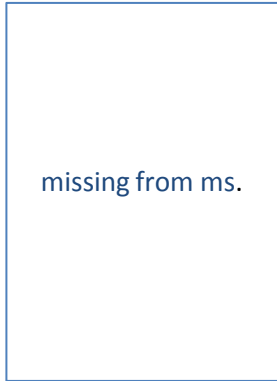

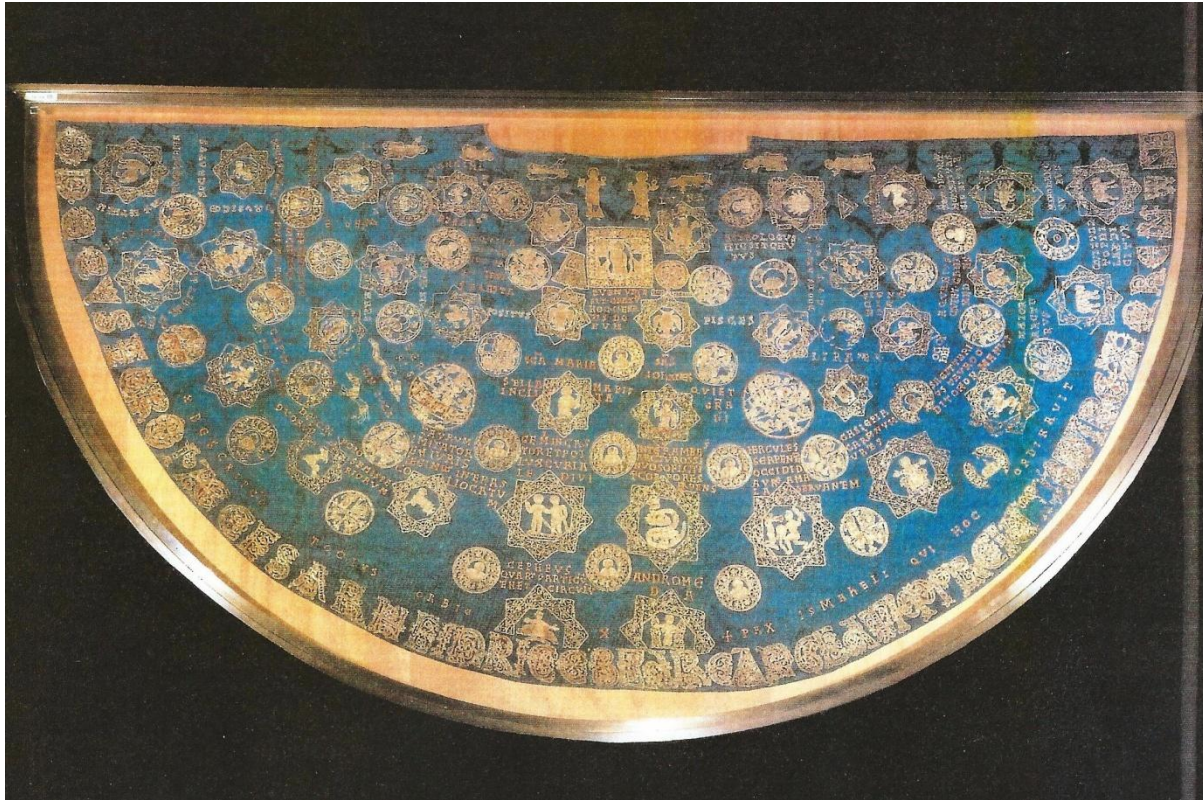

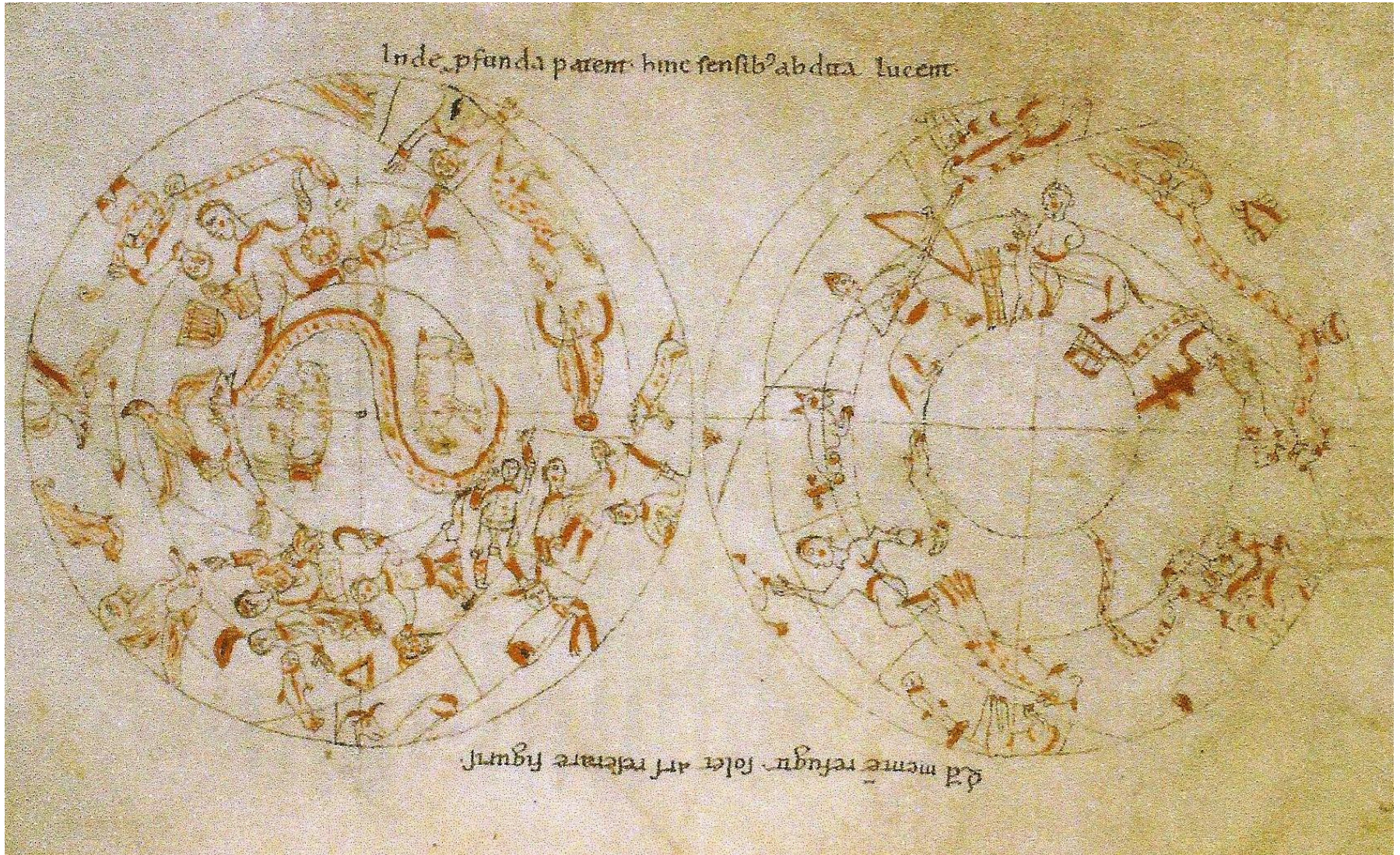

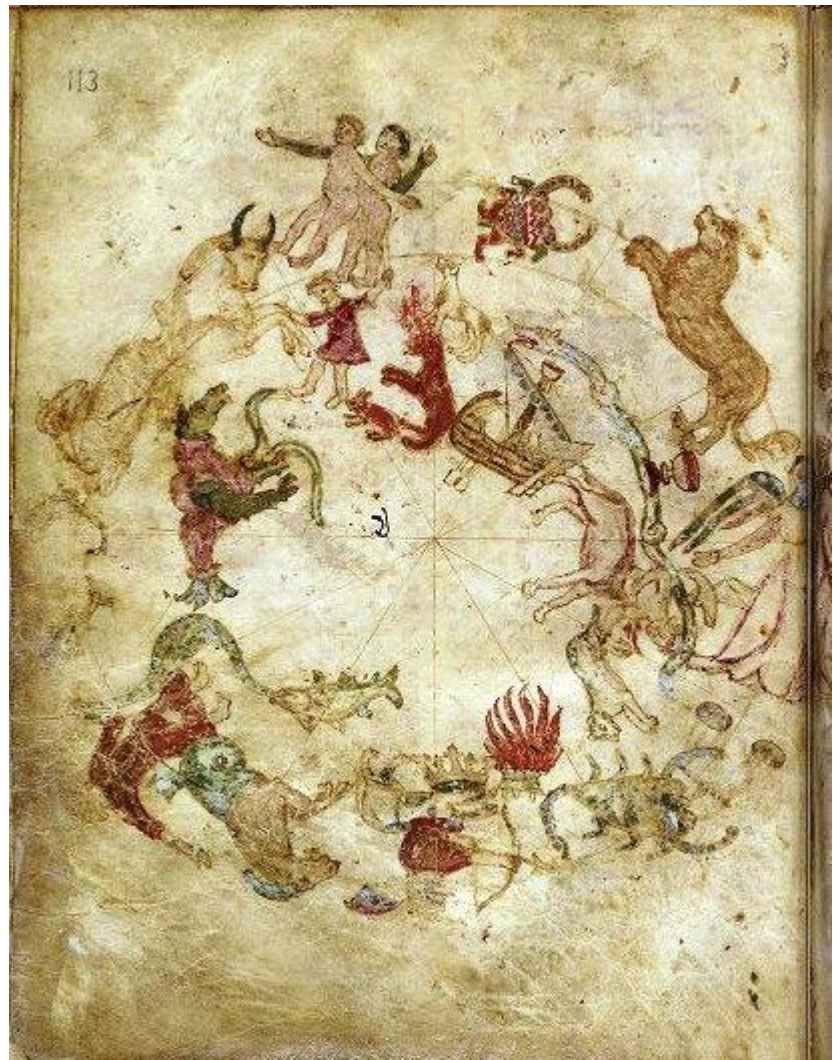

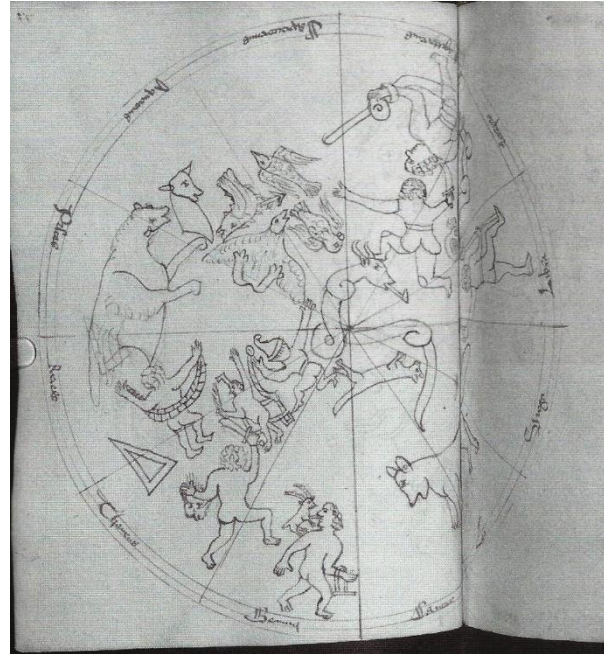

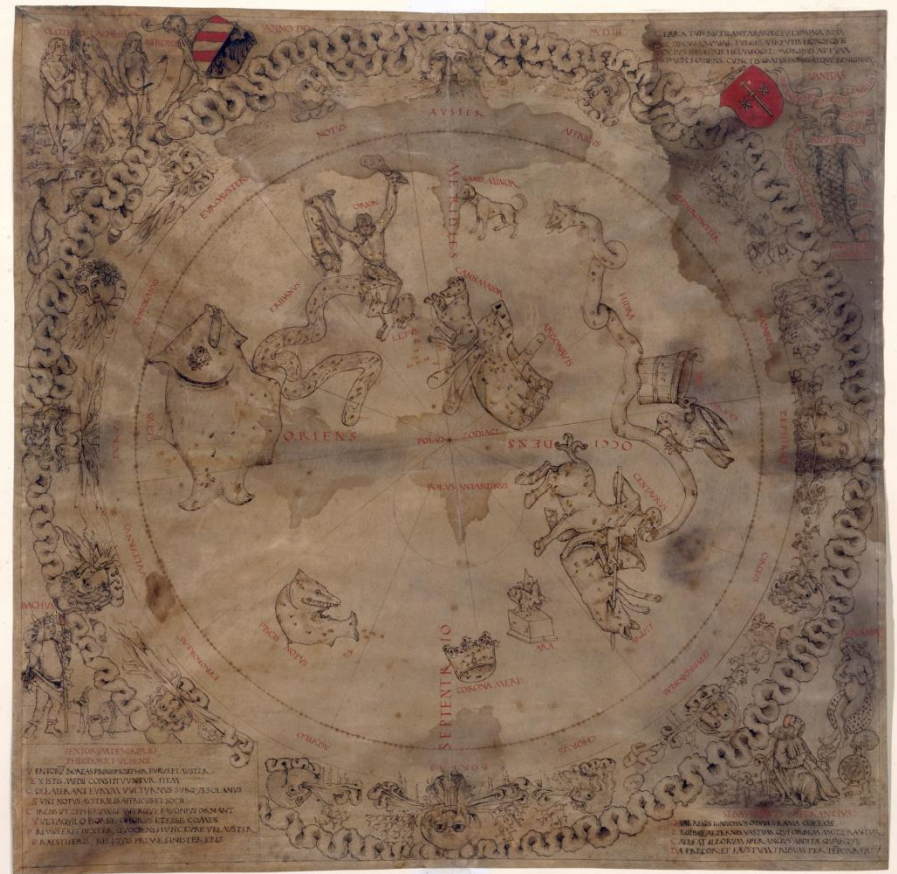
