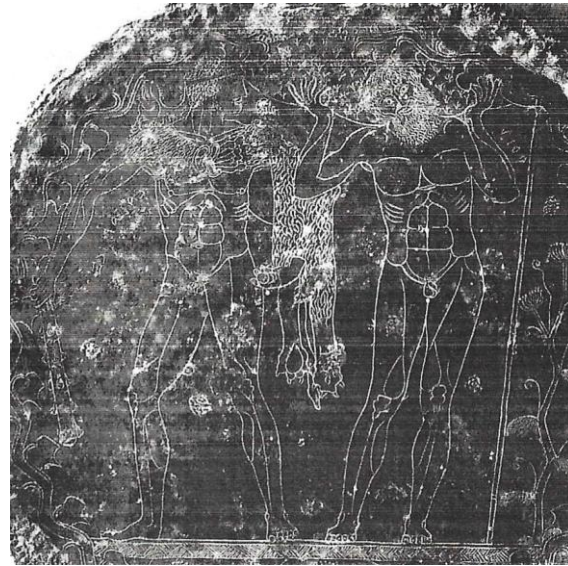

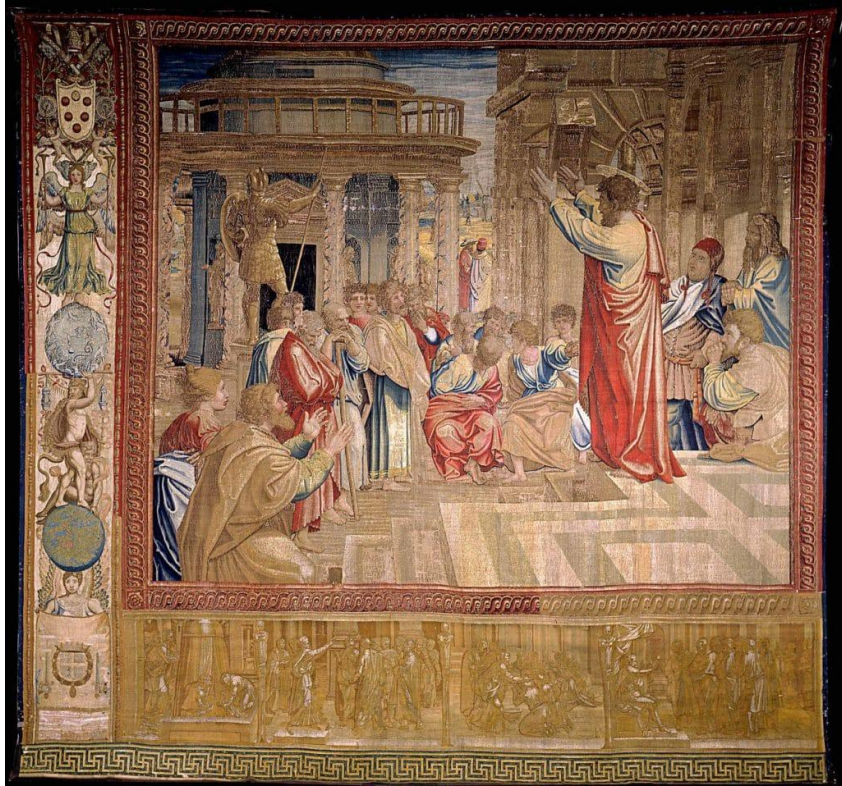

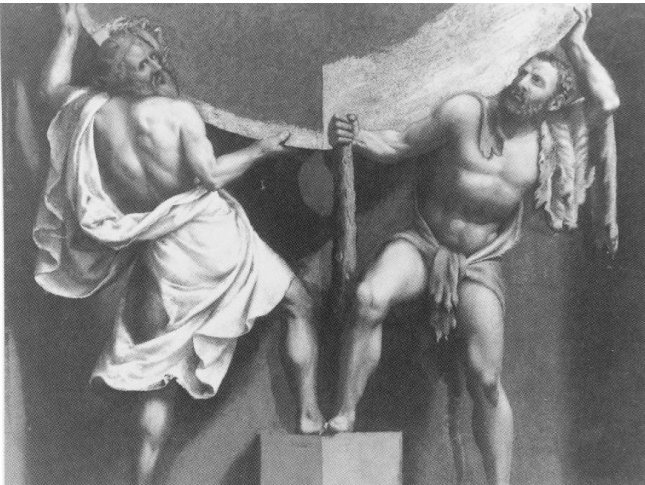

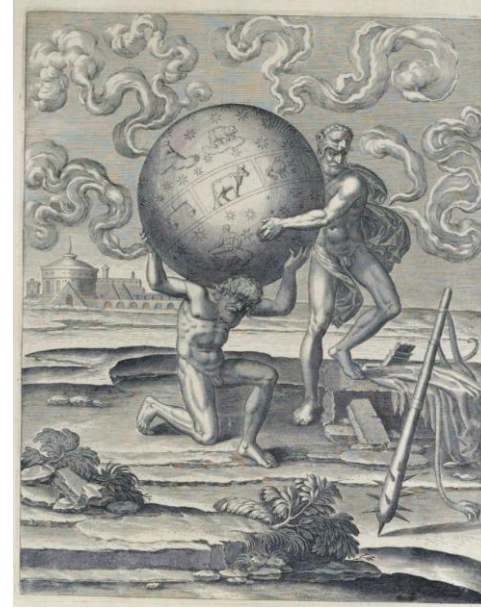


Hans Mielich, detail from illustration

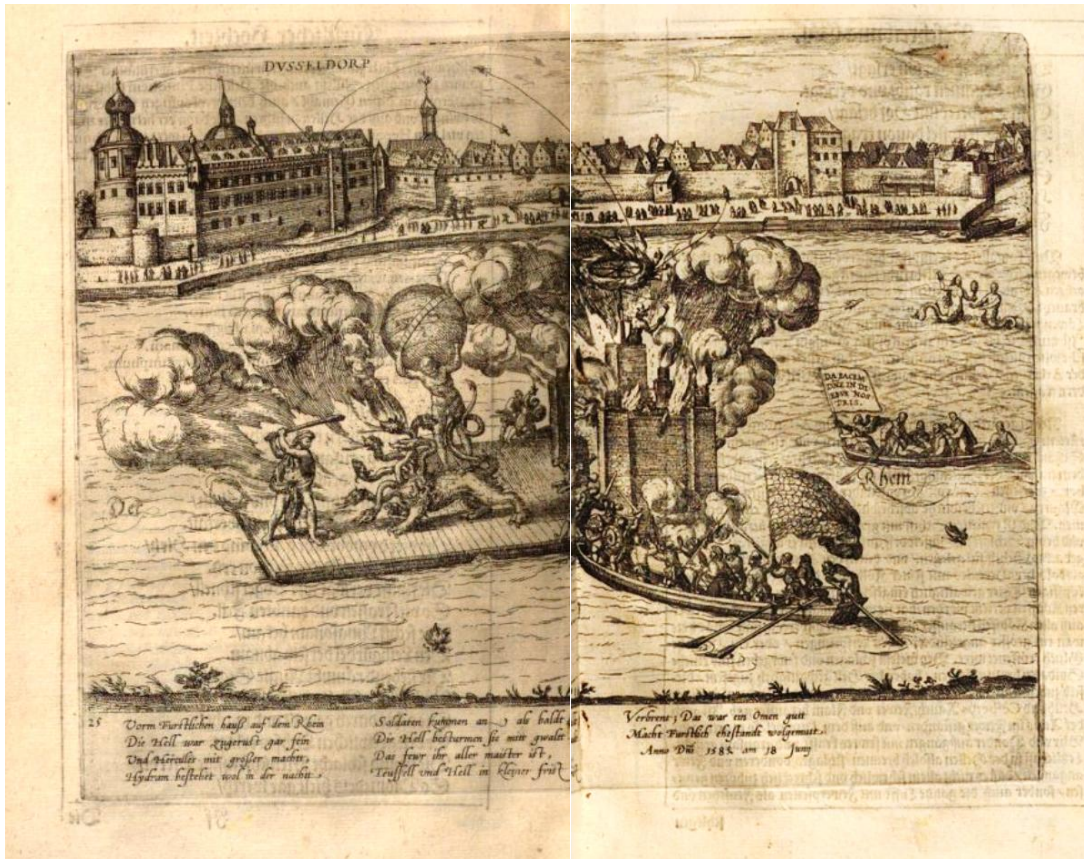

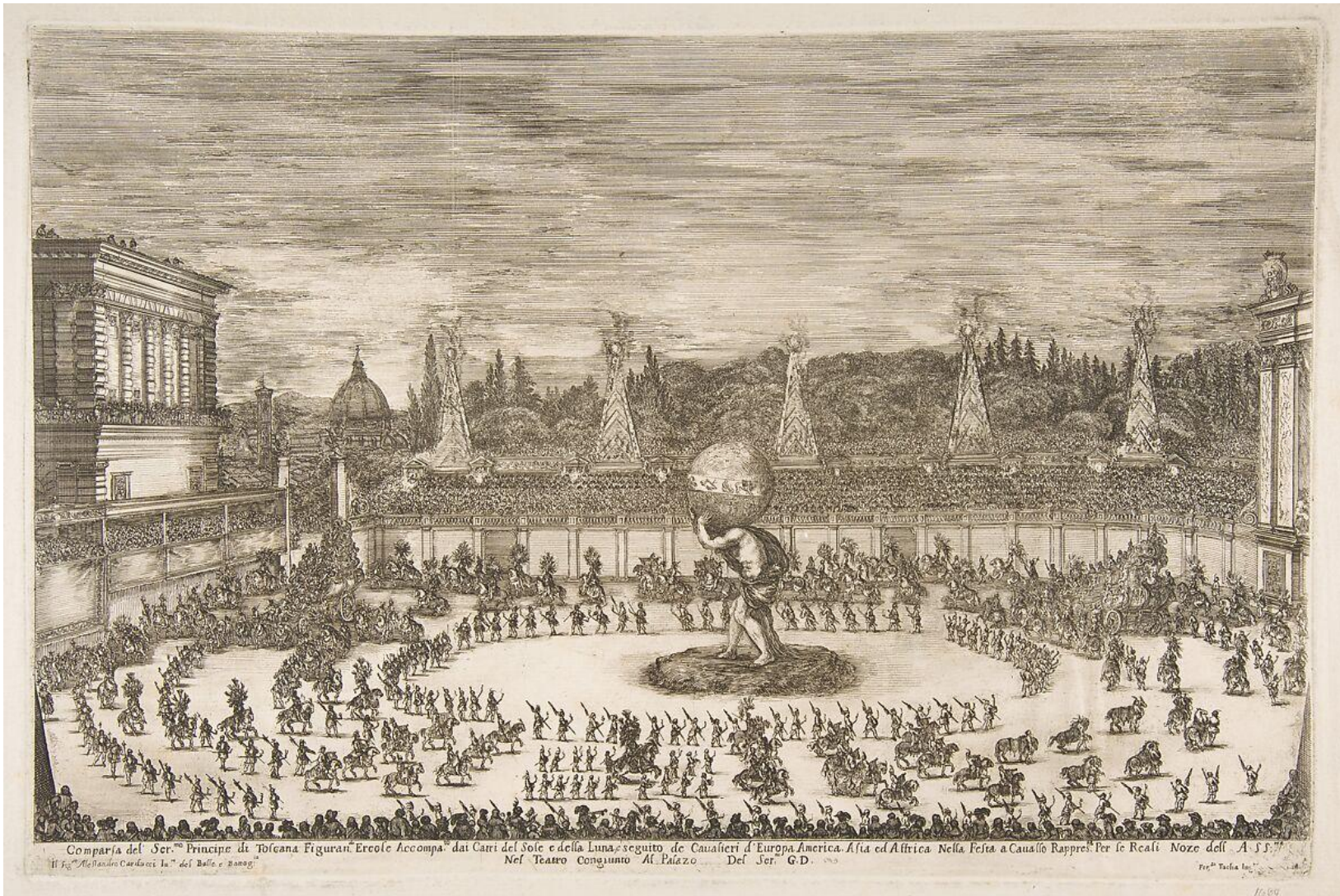

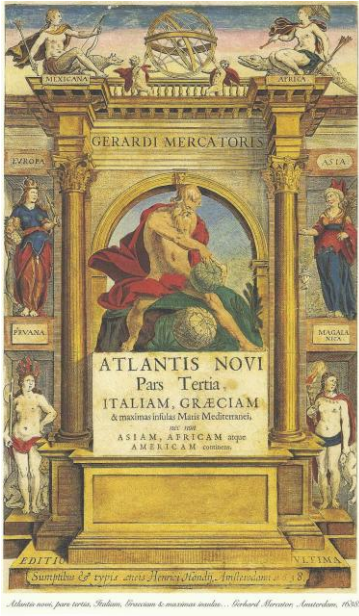
